Our next FUNdraiser will take place on Monday, October 8th (Columbus Day). We will be traveling by bus to the Sight and Sound Theatre in Lancaster, PA to see "Jonah", the story of the Bible's most famous runaway. We will be departing the church at 10AM stopping at the Kitchen Kettle Village at 12 noon and staying there until about 1PM. From there we will be going to the Cupboard Family Restaurant while you will sit and enjoy your meal. We will leave the restaurant at approximately 3PM and arrive at Sight and Sound Theatre at about 3:30PM. A live production of "Jonah" will begin at 4:15PM. After a wonderful day sight seeing, eating, and entertainment, we will depart Lancaster at about 7PM and return to the Absecon Presbyterian Church at approximately 9PM.
