Come and welcome Pastor and Mrs. Cobb home from vacation!

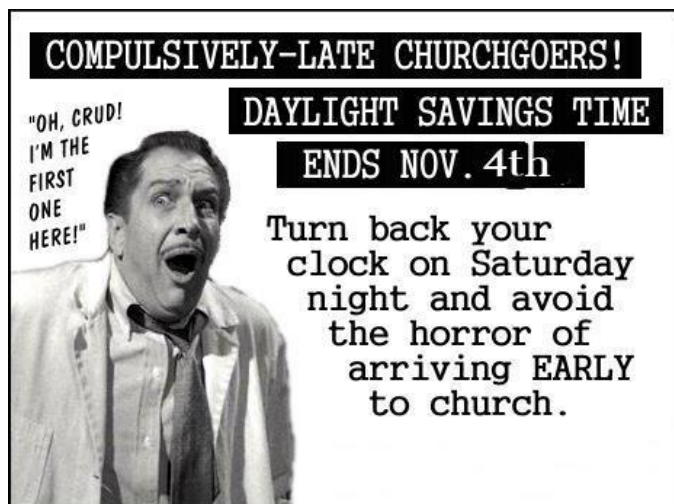

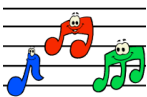
### Christmas Musical: The Bethlehem Project
