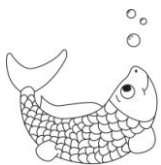
Lent begins next Wednesday, and we will be giving out daily devotional booklets and magnets to aid you in your Lenten Journey.

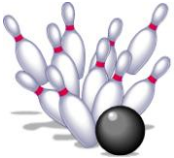
