The Rev. Dr. Karen R. Moritz is the PCUSA Mission Coworker in Prague, Czech Republic. She was born in Sanford, Florida and ordained in Jacksonville. As a "Navy Brat" and minister she has lived all over the US in the South, East, and Midwest and now resides in Prague. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Coe College in Cedar Rapids, a Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary, and a Doctor of Ministry degree from San Francisco Theological Seminary. She has served as a hospital chaplain, parish pastor and university chaplain and has completed her third year of service as a mission coworker. Her service has been renewed for a second term so she will serve for at least three more years. She works with our partner denomination the Evangelical Church of Czech Brethren. The ECCB is the largest Protestant denomination in the Czech Republic, and Karen works as a bridge between ECCB and PCUSA congregations and individuals.
