Our annual Harvest Home collection continues through November 17. See the Deacons' display table for a list of needed items and to leave your donations. Gently used coats can be left in the box by the table.

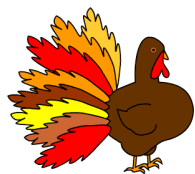
