CWS distributes these along with other Gift of the Heart kits (School & Baby Kits and Clean up Buckets) to families who have been displaced due to severe weather, etc. helping to provide a small sense of normalcy in their lives. CWS has issued an urgent appeal for people to replenish its rapidly dwindling supply of kits.

Hygiene Kits include all of the items below sealed in a one gallon zip-lock plastic bag.



- 1 – hand towel (approximately 16” x 28”, no fingertip or bath towels)
- 1 – washcloth
- 1 – wide-tooth comb (remove from package)
- 1 – nail clipper (no metal files or emery boards; remove from package)
- 1 – bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1 – toothbrush (in original packaging)
- 6 – Band-Aids® or other adhesive bandage strips

Please do not add toothpaste. Toothpaste with an extended expiration date will be added to Hygiene Kit shipments just prior to shipment.

Seal all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure. (Value: \$10)

Our contemporary singing group will meet at 12:30 Sunday. They will lead us in worship on March 9 at the 9:30 service.

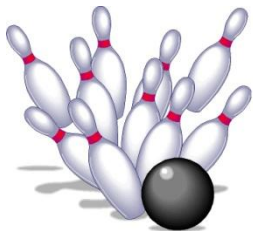
