**Volunteers Needed.**

The week beginning Monday, August 21, through Friday, August 25, we are in need of Volunteer Hosts for our Day Center. We are breaking each day into a **morning shift (from 8am until 12:30)** and an afternoon shift (12:30 until 5). The times will by necessity be flexible depending on the arrival of our Van Drivers (usually, around 8am and 5pm)...

What does a Day Center Host do? It's easy. Our Day Center is a temporary home-base for our Guests. Here they can feel safe while caring for their children, showering, doing laundry, looking for a job or housing on the internet, or just relaxing. You will be our representative, an adult presence, interacting with the parents or playing a game with the children. Sometimes, you just sit back and enjoy a book or the newspaper while our Guests are involved in their own business. There is no babysitting involved. Each parent must be present on site with their children at all times. And, no cooking, no cleaning, no laundry.
