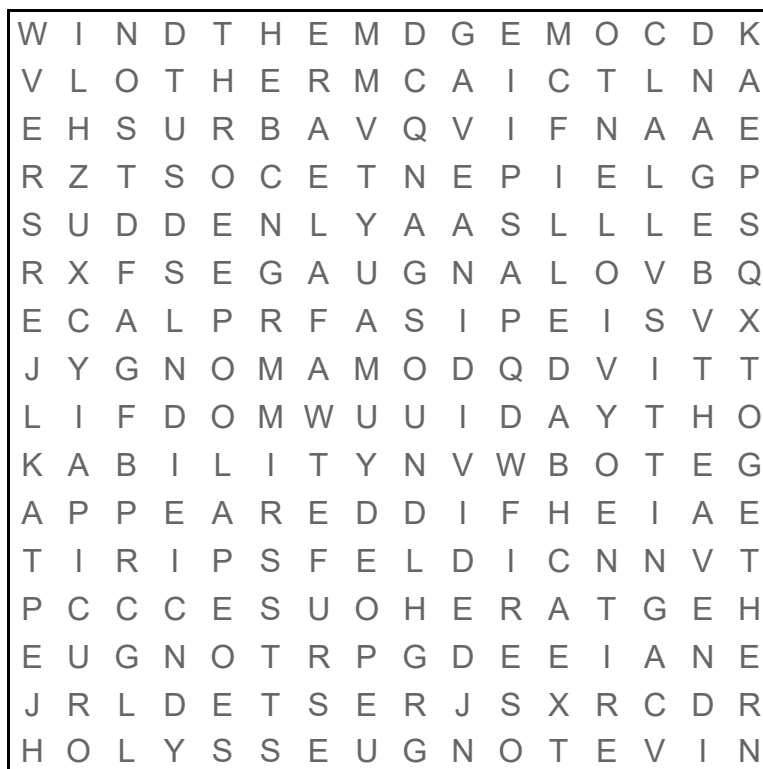
Word Search Puzzle
